C. Glover Middle School Replacement

Recommendation:

It is recommended a contract be awarded to Jackson Contractor Group, Inc., in the amount of \$40,685,000 for the Glover Middle School Replacement Project to include the base bid amount as well as Alternates 1A, 2B, 3, 4, 5, 6A, 8A, 9C, 10, 11B, 11C and 12.

Background:

The project to replace Glover Middle School consists of a new 140,024 square foot building which meets the educational specifications set forth by the School Board in June 2019. The base bid for this project is \$39,094,300.00 which is under the architect's estimate.

There were a total of three experienced general contractors that submitted bids for this project with Jackson Contractor Group deemed the low responsible and responsive contractor.

This project will be funded with 2018 bond dollars with work scheduled to begin on or about March 16, 2020 and be completed on or before August 26, 2021. It is further recommended that the Board authorize a construction contingency for this project in the amount of five percent (5%) to accommodate potential unforeseen conditions associated with abatement and demolition of the existing facility.
