IMMUNIZATIONS

Parents of students that are not adequate with their immunizations were contacted during the summer from the district office. If you received a letter stating that we were missing immunization dates, please contact the school. Students in kindergarten need to be compliant by October 17 and students in grades 1-6 need to be completed by October 11. Any student that is not properly immunized will be excluded from school.

FALL WEATHER HAS ARRIVED

Fall weather has arrived! Even though the afternoons are mild, the mornings have been chilly. Remember that students must line up before school and go outside for morning recess. The fresh air and exercise are a vital part of a child's day. Please ensure that your child is coming to school dressed for fall weather.
