KINDERGARTEN/NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

Registration for kindergarten and new students in grades 1-6 for the 2020/21 school year will begin on March 2.

Students entering kindergarten must be five years of age on or before August 31. The school will need an original birth certificate and immunization records showing the following:

- 4 DTaP with the last dose after the 4th birthday
- 3 IPV (polio) if the last dose is given on or after age 4 or 4 doses if all were given before age 4
- 3 doses of HEP B (hepatitis B). This is a series of three injections given over an 8 month period
- 2 Varicella (chicken pox) given on or after the 1st birthday and at least 28 days apart or a signed verification of disease from a health care provider
- 2 MMR received on or after 1 year of age and at least 28 days apart

New for the 2020/21 school year, the immunization form will need to be filled out by a doctor or we will need the immunization print out from the doctor.
