## Health Check Required

### Visitors:

Everyone entering the building is required to complete a Health Check for COVID-19 symptoms. Visitors are asked to complete the check before pressing the call button on the intercom to the office at the front entrance.

### Students:

Students attending day camp, receiving in person special education services and kindergarteners transitioning back to in person learning, are required to have a health check form completed by their parent or guardian. Please complete the health check for your student 30 minutes prior to arrival so it adequately registers in our computer system and notifies staff that your child is cleared to be in the building.
