Parents, please send your student with extra masks for school. It's helpful to have extra masks at school just in case.




From our Librarian, Rachel Peters

From our Nurse: COVID Health and Safety Info



- Fever of 100.4 or higher or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Unusual fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose not related to seasonal allergies
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

Per the Spokane Health District guidelines the school will need either:

- 1. A doctor's note to excuse them.
- 2. A negative Covid test (not a rapid test).
- 3. If #1 or #2 is not possible then the student will need to stay home 10 days from the onset of symptoms.
