Hutton, and all schools. In Spokane Public Schools, we utilize Blackboard Messenger to send recorded phone calls, test messages and emails to families. This is the main form of communication if an emergency arises.

If you are not receiving emails, it is possible that the email on file is incorrect or that you have unsubscribed in the past.

If you are not receiving text messages, it can mean the phone number Hutton has in the system is incorrect or that texts from the school and district have been blocked. To ensure that texts have not been blocked, simply text the word "START" to 60680.
