Fit 4 Bloomsday Spring Break workouts to focus on adding speed to your runs:

- Find an object in your run like a fire hydrant and run as fast as you can to it.
- Jog down the block and when at the end, turn around and race back as fast at you can. Do this for 10 minutes.
- 3. Get on a track or grass field and run 100 yards as fast as you can. Do 10. Speedwork doesn't just make you run faster. It makes you fitter, increases the range of movement in your joints, makes you more comfortable at all speeds, and it will ultimately help you to run harder for longer.

### **Pesticide Application Notice**

This is to inform you that our annual dormant oil spray will be applied to the trees and shrubs at hutton on Friday, April 8th (during spring break). This spray application consists of 1 gallon of mineral oil mixed in 80 gallons of water to cover and kill dormant insect eggs that winter over in our area. We ask that you and your child refrain from making contact with or playing around the trees and shrubs at our school. A variation from this schedule may occur as a result of inclement weather.
