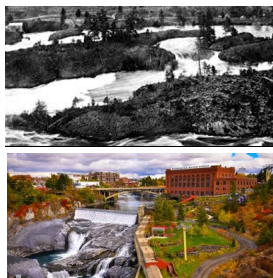
I also wanted to inform you that **State Testing will be held May 10 – June 3rd** at Hutton for students in grades 3-6. Your help is needed and appreciated. We ask that you make every attempt to be sure your child is present and on time for school, to ensure they do not miss their testing sessions. It is important to support healthy habits as well. Sleep and nutrition can have a significant impact on your child's ability to focus. It is especially important that your child gets a good night's sleep and starts the day with a filling breakfast. Stay calm and positive about the assessments. Take the time to talk with your child about how they are feeling about the tests. Offer reassurance or perspective if they have any anxiety around the exams. Also, a little encouragement can go a long way in helping students walk into testing days feeling confident. Your child's teacher will be providing more information about specific testing days for their classroom.

Reporting Student Illness

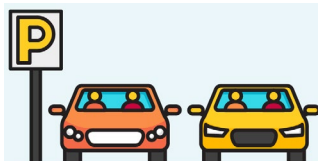

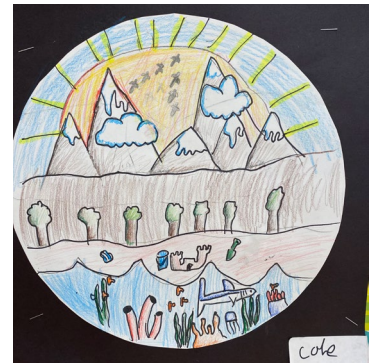

Earth Day, April 22, 2022

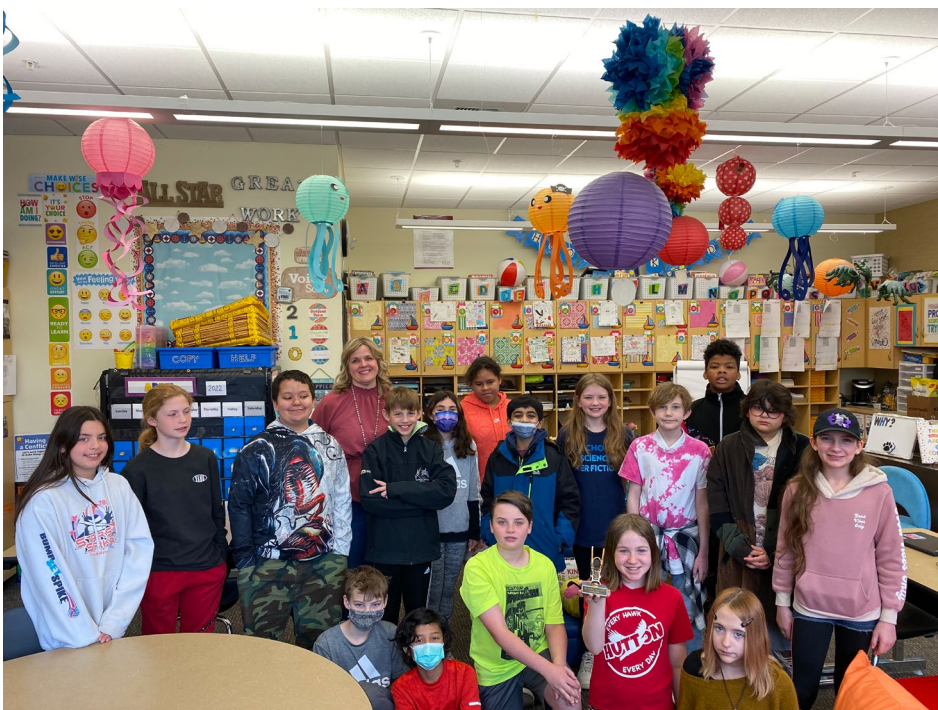
We celebrated Earth Day here at Hutton by decorating our Earth Bags (Donated by PTG's Green Club. Thank you, Green Club!).
