Thank you once again for your unwavering support. I wish you all a wonderful summer and look forward to another incredible year ahead.

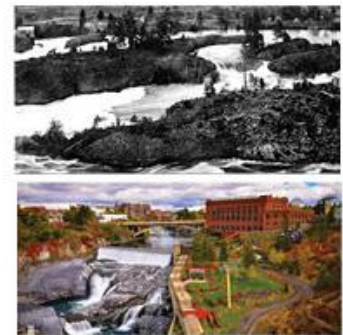

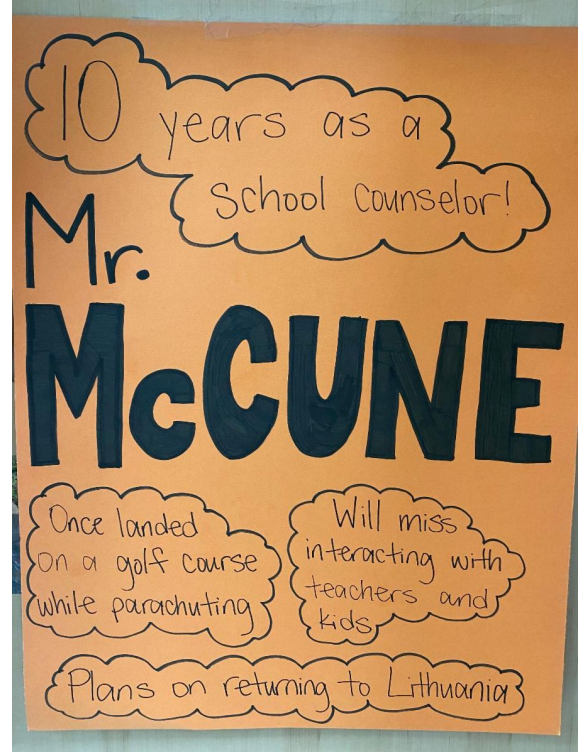

Important School Information

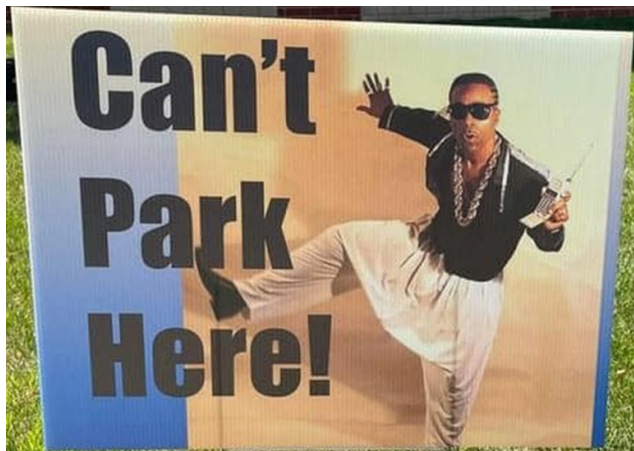
From the Nurse
