



Sensory Paths

We are excited to announce that Hutton Elementary has recently installed a sensory path in our Kindergarten and 1st grade wing. Sensory paths are designated routes on the floor, often marked by colorful shapes and instructions, designed to engage students in physical activity and stimulate their senses. These paths are especially beneficial for children who may need a break to refocus, relieve stress, or expend energy in a positive way. Schools that implement sensory paths often see improvements in concentration, emotional regulation, and even academic performance among their students. We invite families to visit and experience the sensory path themselves, as we believe this will be a valuable asset in making our school a more inclusive and welcoming environment that will serve the needs of all students.




Morning Arrival, Breakfast and More!

Students who are not eating breakfast at school are allowed on campus beginning at 8:15 AM. Students line up in their designated line up spot (See MAP Below) and are picked up by their teachers and walked into the building. Dismissal doors at the end of the day

are the same; EXCEPT FOR... Mrs. Campbell, Mrs. Lipsker, Mrs. Pedersen, and Mrs. Dhaenens. These four classrooms dismiss to the parent loop through the SW door.

Students wishing to eat breakfast may arrive on campus to eat after 8:00 AM. Breakfast eaters will enter into the cafeteria through the blacktop doors and eat inside the cafeteria. *Mondays are professional collaboration days and school does not start until 9:30 AM, so breakfast would begin at 9:00 AM. Breakfast is made available to all students up to 10:00 AM.

Students need to head directly home after school as the playground is open only to students in Express.





Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards

Students who ride bikes and scooters to school should be governed by the following:

- Parents make the decision as to whether their child may or may not ride a bike to school. It is the recommendation of the school that students in grades K-2 should not ride bikes or scooters to school unless accompanied by an adult.
 - All bicycles and scooters must be parked in the racks provided, and locked. They should not be locked together. The school does not accept

responsibility for damaged or stolen bikes or scooters.

- 3. Bikes and scooters must be "walked" across patrolled crossings, and on school grounds when coming to or leaving school.
- 4. Heelys and skateboards are not permitted at school.
- 5. Helmets are required. An ordinance enacted by the Spokane City Council requires all people to wear a helmet when riding their bikes, or scooters, etc. on streets, sidewalks, and other public property. Students attending schools located withing the city must therefore wear a helmet when riding their bikes or scooters to and from school.

Many children in the Spokane area are treated each year for bicycle-related injuries that are sometimes critical or cause life-long brain damage. The goal of the City ordinance is to help reduce the number of head injuries among young people by requiring helmet use.

Dogs

Even the friendliest dog can cause problems on a playground full of children. In compliance with our district wide policy, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON SCHOOL PREMISES. Only service animals are allowed inside the school without advanced written permission of school administration.
