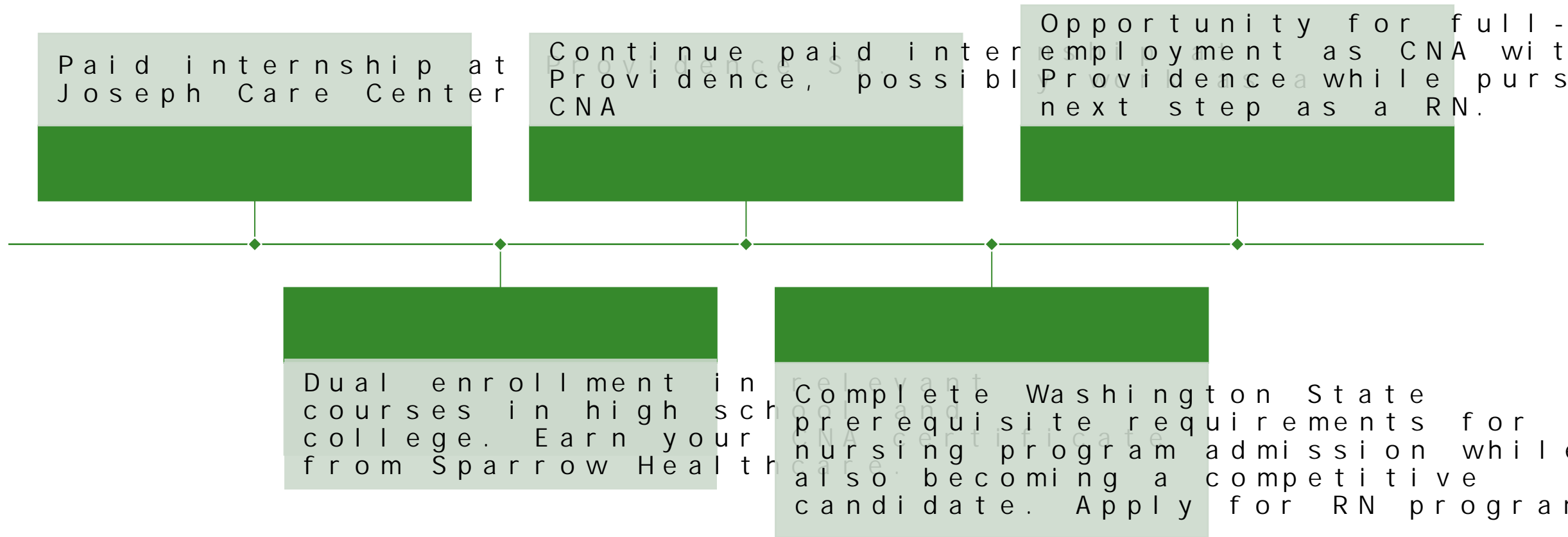

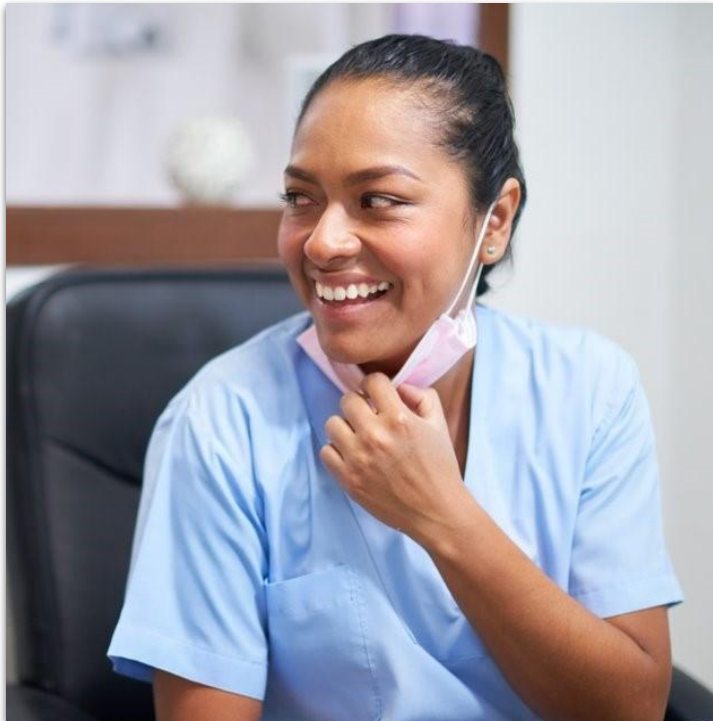

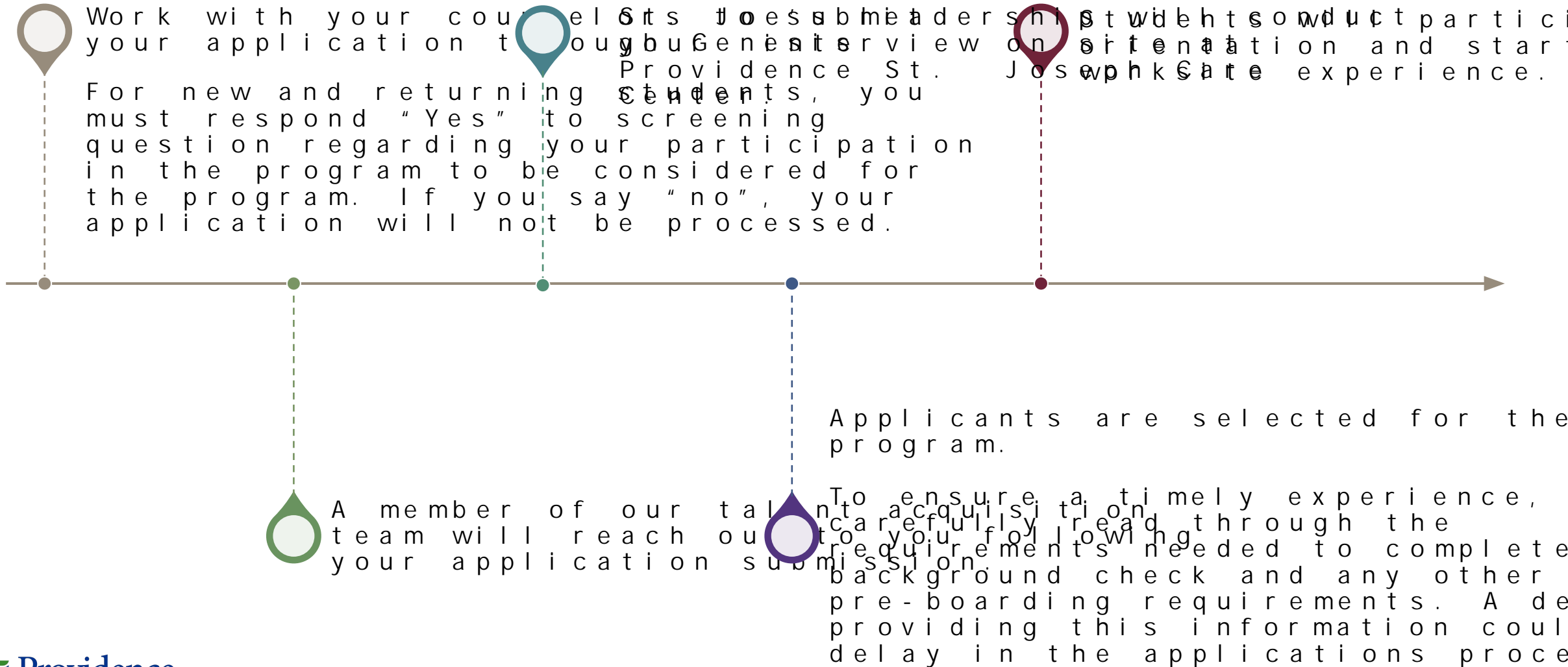

- Resume can be any format you choose and should include
  - Your name and contact information (phone number)
  - Your skills and strengths
  - Your work and/or volunteer experience
  - Relevant classes you have taken
  - Honors and awards you have received
- Submitting with your application is preferred but not required.
- Upload in PDF file format
- If you need assistance with completing your resume, contact a Career Ready Counselor in the Career Center

# Identifying Counselor Or Teacher Recommendation

You will be required to have a teacher or counselor Letter of Recommendation which speaks to your skills and character as a potential candidate.

In your application, you will provide the name and address of the teacher or counselor you have selected as a reference on your behalf.

Upon completion of your application, the person you identified will be contacted by email to confirm their letter and where to submit their letter. Your teacher or counselor recommendation will be sent directly to the Providence Care Center and not to you.

Important: Discuss with the person you have selected to write your letter before submitting their name as part of your application.
