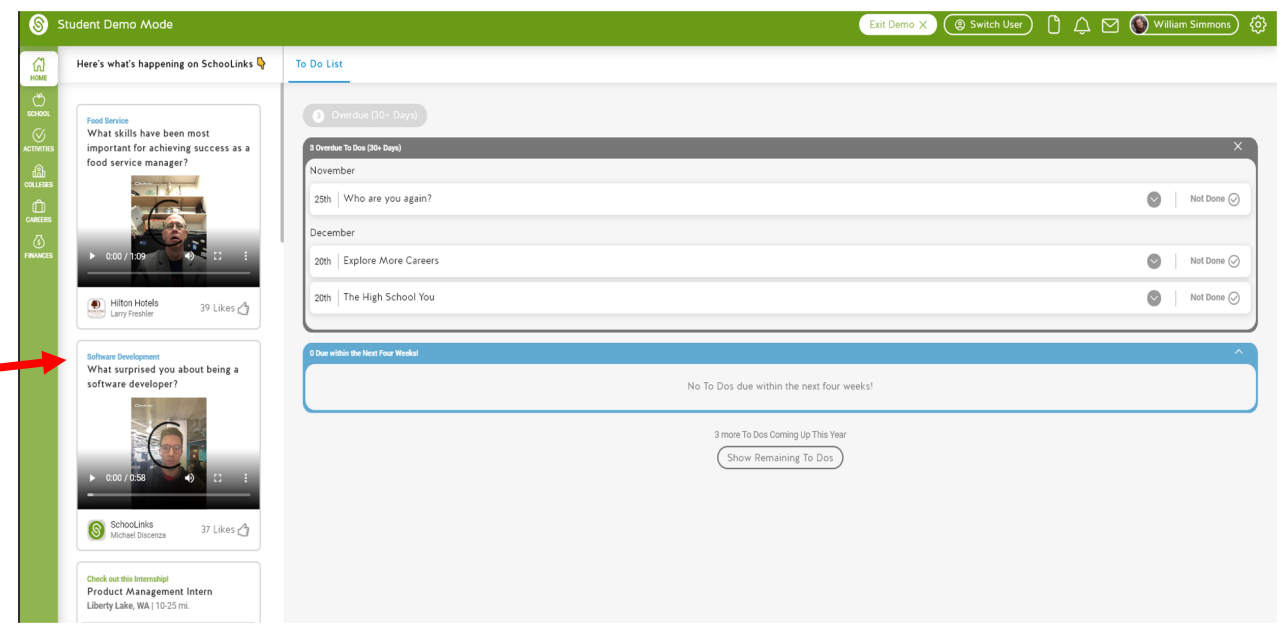
Where is SchooLinks?

Accessing Scholarship Matching
