Shadle Park High School is a comprehensive urban high school located in the northwest region of Spokane, Washington. Its long-standing traditions are grounded in Scottish heritage, as evidenced in their spirited bagpipe band and Highland dancer troupe; both perform at school and community events. Shadle Park serves a student body of about 1,300 in grades 9 through 12 and offers courses from a wide variety of robust programs: Advanced Placement; Career and Technical Education; and the Visual and Performing Arts, to name a few. Additionally, there are over 70 enriching co-curricular activities to engage students in the following areas: athletics, visual and performing arts, science, business and marketing, and service-oriented organizations.

#### MATRICULATION FOR CLASS OF 2022

Shadle Park's 2022 seniors are enrolled in 25 different post-secondary institutions. From a graduating class of 222, 37 percent have gone on to pursue further education at two- and four-year colleges. 16 percent are enrolled in two-year programs, while 22 percent are persuing four-year degrees. 32 students are attending private colleges, and 51 are attending public colleges.


