- Every member of our program is special, important, and critical to our success. We will treat everyone with respect and kindness everyday. We will also show up with positive attitudes and be ready to work knowing that our individual attendance and effort is critical to the groups' success.
- Class starts promptly when the tardy bell has rung. Your instrument(s), sheet music, warm-up materials, pencil, and any other necessary items must be fully ready allowing you to start the rehearsal on time. You will be assessed a tardy if this is not accomplished.
- You will not be permitted to leave the classroom unless it is an emergency. Take care of all needs prior to the start of class.
- Be careful and respectful of all the equipment around you in the room. Many dollars have been spent to make this program successful and it is expected that you will treat all equipment with care. Any damage resulting from your negligence or carelessness will be your financial responsibility.
- All equipment must be properly put away for safekeeping at the end of each and every rehearsal and event.
- Practice rooms are only to be used with instructor permission.
- Uniforms are required at every performance/event. Failure to follow the uniform code will result in removal from the event and an unexcused absence according to the grading policy.
- All school codes of conduct, band program expectations, and government laws apply to any concerts/events/trips. Failure to meet expectations may result in removal from the activity and the student being transported home at the parent/guardians expense.
- An instrumental music program takes a great deal of community and member support. You are **expected** to assist with fundraising activities and/or accept the fees associated with traveling.

- Each member of the program is expected to maintain a music folder with every piece of music we play in it. All music will be collected at the end of the year. Missing parts will cost \$10 per song.
