We believe that all students should participate in stretch learning, recognizing that this looks different for each student based on individual strengths and talents.

Schedules changes which CAN be fulfilled:

- Missing a course required to fulfill a graduation requirement
- Less than six classes
- Error in schedule
- Based on course availability, a change in elective

Schedule changes which CANNOT be fulfilled:

- The desire for a specific teacher/class period/lunch/etc.
- Dropping a dual-credit (AP, CiHS) or honors course before the beginning of the semester (exceptions made based on overall academic rigor within a student's schedule)
- Dropping a math course in the junior year or CADR required quantitative course in senior year
